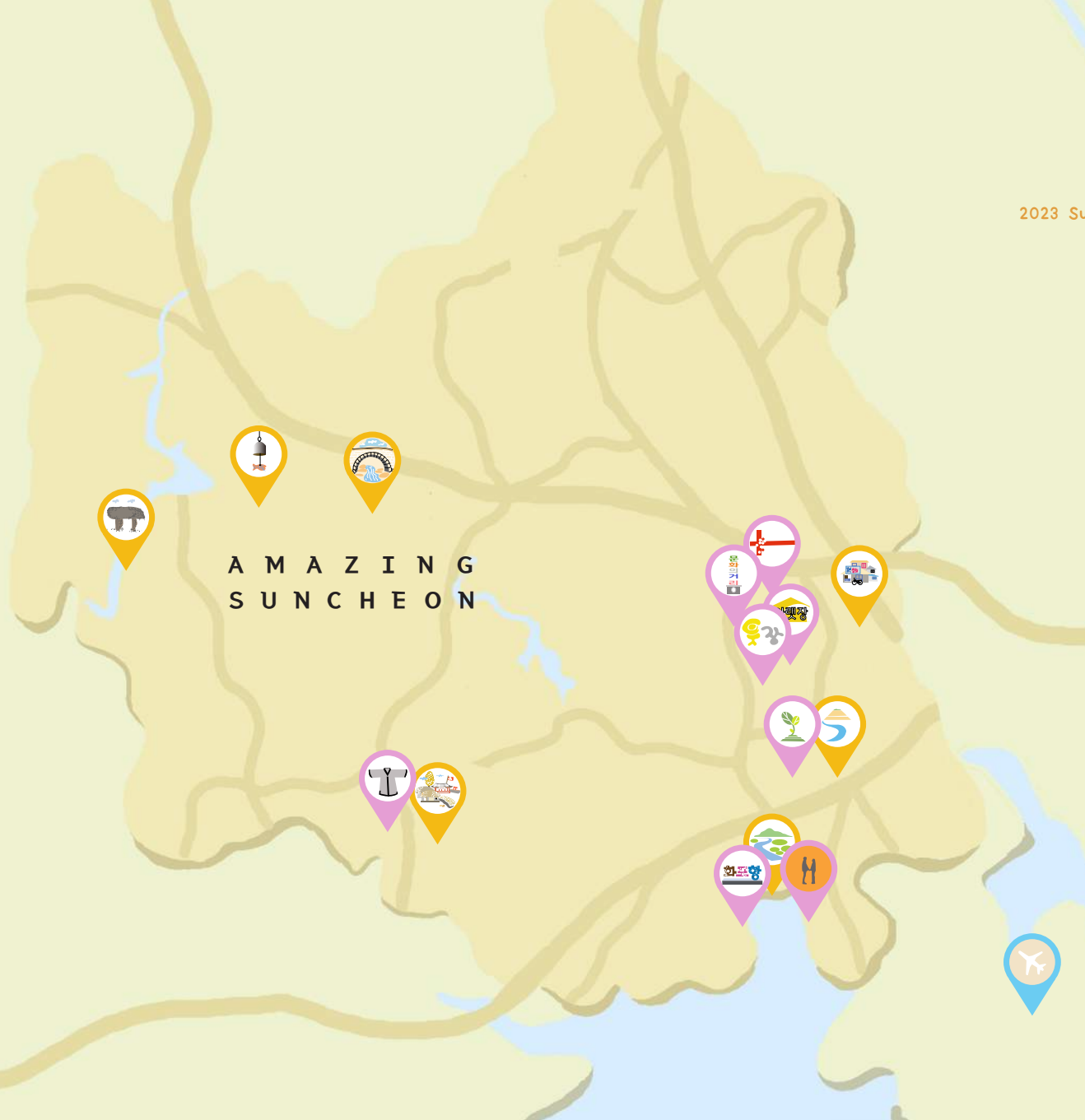

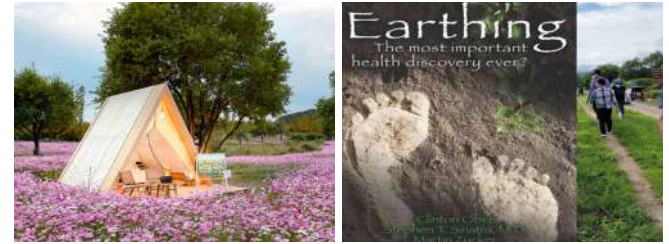

2023 Suncheon Bay International Garden Expo



Ten years from the 2013 Suncheon Bay International Garden Expo, through new Expo directions and analysis of visitors' traffic lines, the Suncheon Bay National Garden has removed a part of its garden and renewed the participation garden formation region into the Stream and the Stream Plaza. Also, the traffic lines of Ferris wheel are moved to the outer side and transformed into Eosing Roads(8 places) on which visitors can walk barefoot on the lawn or the land with trees. In addition, the tree screens between gardens are removed and dense trees are moved to other places to form broader gardens.



Check Point The Garden formed on the water of Dongcheon Stream passing through the center of Suncheon City provides the night view along the Dongcheon Stream, the city's landscape, and splendid night view of Suncheon City on the ship called Jungwon Dream.

Check Point Korea's first national garden, Suncheonman National Garden consists of the Themed Garden with the Suncheon Lake Garden designed by the world-renowned garden designer Charles Jencks, 13 country-themed gardens, and other participatory gardens.



The history of Suncheonman National Garden began with the success of the 2013 Suncheonman International Garden Expo. After the expo, Suncheon City Government remodeled the garden and opened it as Suncheonman Garden on April 20, 2014. Currently, Suncheonman National Garden has been highly praised as a model example of the utilization and globalization of local ecotourism resources, and the garden was designated as Korea's first National Garden on September 5, 2015. With around five million visitors per year, Suncheonman National Garden has proved its brand value as the first national garden.

Suncheonman Wetland

Suncheonman Bay is located at the center of Korea's southern coast and boasts the most beautiful sceneries and the richest biodiversity in Korea. The coastal wetland offers a harmonious combination of wide mudflats, reed fields at the river entrance, salty wetlands, rice paddies, rivers, and mountains. This well-preserved natural beach offers a home to various migratory birds and marine life. The Suncheonman mudflats, river basins, and farmlands are managed as National Wetland Protection Areas. They are also internationally recognized Ramsar Wetlands. Suncheonman Wetland's ecology axis connecting the coasts and the inland area is popular as a place of ecological learning for future generations.

Suncheon Filming Location is Korea's largest movie/TV show set with faithful recreations of shabby towns in Bongcheon-dong, Gwanak-gu, Seoul from the 1960 to 1980s. To make the set seem as authentic as possible, the staff even used wastes collected from the shanty town (called "Moon Village" or daldongne) that was demolished. The open set reminds visitors of the heart-warming memories of their favorite films and shows. The many famed movies and shows filmed at the set include Love and Ambition (2006, TV series, SBS); Giant (2010, TV series); Gangnam Blues (2014, film); Young Fire (2019, TV series); and Boston 1947 (2020).

Check Point The Filming Location is Korea's largest filming set for period pieces with recreations of Korea's 1960s to 1980s. The numerous shows and films shot at the set include Love and Ambition, and East of Eden.

On June 30th, 2018, the temple was listed to UNESCO world heritage. Walking down to the valley from the entrance, you can find a rainbow-like Seungseongyo bridge(national treasure no.400), having a sign 'the most beautiful in Korea' and Gangseonru. Visitors may be attracted by white apricot blossom behind the wall of Wonreungjeon and white apricot blossom, which is designated as the natural monument no.488, along the wall of Gakhwangjeon.

Songgwangsa Temple



Songgwangsa Temple is like the eldest son's family out of the Jogye Order temples in Korea. It is officially rated as Seungbojongchal among Samboschal temples together with Haeinsa temple and Tongdosa temple, which produced most priests of high virtue. Tongdosa temple enshrining Jinsinsari of Buddha is called Bulbosachal temple, Haeinsa temple enshrining Palmandaejanggyeong, the teachings of Buddha is called Beobosachal temple while Songgwangsa temple connecting the priests group of Korean Buddhism is called Seungbosachal temple.

Check Point The temple was also one of the filming locations of Park Chan-wook's *Decision to Leave*, for which the director one the 2022 Cannes Best Director Award.

Naganeupseong Walled Town



Naganeupseong Walled Town is the first area where both the fortress and the village were designated as Historic Site No. 302. Located 22 km from Suncheon's city center, the Walled Town attracts tourists with faithfully preserved fortress walls, magistrate's office, guestrooms, and thatched roof houses. The village has a proud history of fighting off Japanese pirates; in 1397(6th year of King Taejo's reign in the Joseon Dynasty), a local general named Kim Bin-gil gathered villagers to build earthen fortification and fight off the pirates.

Check Point The fortress walls were built under the leadership of General Im Gyeong-eop during the reign of King Injo. The walls still retain their original forms.

Check Point Around 600 everyday objects personally used by ancient Koreans, including pottery of the Three Kingdoms Period, Buddhist utensils, and earthenware.

Suncheon City Deep Rooted Tree Museum holds around 6,500 artifacts from the personal collection of the late Han Chang-gi, the founder of the magazine Ppurigipeunnamu. The collection is a summation of Suncheon's local traditional culture, ranging from Bronze Age artifacts to items created after the 1945 Liberation of Korea.

Beyond the functions of a detention pond, a new model of detention pond is born as a new community culture space and garden connecting the National Garden and the Dongcheon Stream. The detention pond, which is a facility for preventing disaster in case of floods occurring once a hundred years, is transformed into the representative detention pond garden model in the Republic of Korea. The Ocheon Green Square includes the Lawn Plaza, Ocheon Hill, night view, Tunnel Fountain, Earthing Road, and Marronnier Road for offering the gardens for the citizens to take some rest and have some time to be immersed in thinking.

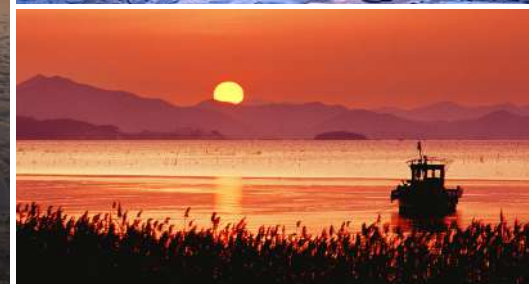
